

# AJA Ki Pro GO – Release Notes v1.0

### Release firmware v1.0 for Ki Pro GO

## Introduction

This firmware is the first release version that ships pre-installed on Ki Pro GO.

### v.1.0 Notes

#### 240 Minute time recording time limit

Version 1.0 of Ki Pro GO stops recording after a maximum duration of 240 minutes. To start another recording, press the record button to generate a follow on recording. For longer events, choosing an appropriate break moment in the action to stop the first recording and start a second will ensure best results. A free future firmware update will automatically create a new clip for longer continuous recording durations.

#### Back up recording to USB 5 destination

Version 1.0 of Ki Pro GO offers redundant recording to the USB 5 port on the rear of the unit. For recommended recording media please see <a href="https://www.aja.com/support/item/6509">https://www.aja.com/support/item/6509</a>.

#### Ki Pro GO Recording notes

Version 1.0 of Ki Pro GO supports encoding H.264 as 8-bit, 4:2:0 files with user selections for low, medium or high. Please see the Ki Pro GO Manual: Appendix A for specifications and more information. <a href="https://www.aja.com/support/item/6515">https://www.aja.com/support/item/6515</a>. A free future firmware update will enhance recording encoding options for those workflows that require it.

#### Timecode support

Version 1.0 does not support timecode input via RP-188 timecode. Ki Pro GO displays the time elapsed during a recording and playback. A free future firmware update will add support for RP-188 timecode.

#### File Playback Note

Ki Pro GO file playback is primarily designed to play back self authored files. If you need to playback H.264 material generated from third party software or other devices, please reference Appendix A for specifications and more information. <a href="https://www.aja.com/support/item/6515">https://www.aja.com/support/item/6515</a> Test your files on the Ki Pro GO before deploying publically. AJA cannot guarantee appropriate playback of 3rd party generated media.



## Firmware Re-install Considerations

- You should not need to re-install v1.0 firmware and these notes are provided as a preliminary guide for future firmware releases.
- AJA recommends a Factory Reset under the CONFIG menu prior to updating firmware.
- After a firmware update, the web browser (Safari, Firefox, etc.) may lose its connection. A refresh of the web browser will
  reconnect the web LII
- Do not attempt firmware updates while recording is in progress. Be sure the device is in the stopped state before performing a firmware update.
